

S.O.A.R Rewards Program winners for Trinity Catholic High School

As part of the adoption of a hybrid and virtual learning model, Trinity Catholic adopted virtual learning expectations known as the S.O.A.R. expectations. The acronym stands for Self-Control, On Task, Achievement, and Respect and was created to identify student and teacher expectations from how best to set up an at-home learning environment to the proper way to engage in an online conversation.
